4. If I miss the Live Classes due to some unavoidable conditions, will the recorded lectures be available on the NEXT IAS App?

Ans: Yes, the recorded lectures will be available on the NEXT IAS App till the resumption of Offline Classes and you can watch it up to 2 times.

5. If COVID CURFEW continues due to extension for a longer period, how will NEXT IAS support us?

Ans: In case Covid curfew is extended in Delhi and if it is not feasible to provide Live classes then we will continue to provide Recorded Online classes with periodic doubt sessions until Covid curfew conditions are relaxed.

6. How to clear our doubts about the recorded lectures? Will there be any doubt clearing sessions?

Ans: Yes, we will be arranging Zoom/Google Meet sessions of respective faculties on weekly basis or as required, to cater to your doubts.

7. Those subjects which are covered through Live Online mode, will they be taught in the classroom also?

Ans: Yes, offline classes will be provided for those subjects also which are covered in live online mode but those students who want to attend again in offline will be required to attend such subjects in extra time with some other batch for CSE 2022 or if time doesn't permit then can attend in new batches which will start in later phase for CSE 2023.

10. Will the weekly tests be conducted during this period and where to submit the subjective answers?

Ans: Yes, the mandatory weekly tests will be conducted as per the schedule. Students can mail their subjective answers to copyevaluation@nextias.com.

11. Can I collect classroom books from the respective centre or through courier services?

Ans: At present, Pusa Road Centre is not operating due to the CURFEW. You can collect the books after the centre re-opens by producing your fee receipt/ID card (if issued). Those students who are unable to collect books by visiting in person then such students can avail the courier/postal services by filling google form the link of which will be sent on registered mail id.

Options	Location	Procedure
1	Delhi Residents	Students can either come to the centre and collect the material themselves after re-opening or can get it at their addresses after filling the Google Form.
2	Rest of India	A Google Form has been mailed to enrolled students, in which all details have to be filled and the books will be sent to respective addresses after the centre re-opens.

Note 1: NEXT IAS Pusa Road, Old Rajinder Nagar Centre will remain closed till Covid Curfew continues in Delhi.
